



## **NRM Plan role**

The Northern Gulf Regional Natural Resource Management (NRM) Plan is a community driven, evidence based, regional “road-map” for:

- brokering partnerships, research & investment into priority areas & programs, and
- adapting to respond to new and emerging opportunities and priorities

...which deliver demonstrable and positive NRM outcomes to the Northern Gulf region.

## **NRM Plan functions**

### *1. Investment Prospectus*

The NRM Plan provides a succinct and clear value proposition for regional investment into NRM, including;

1. climate and carbon related investment;
2. direct action and development offsets;
3. leveraging resources through partnerships;
4. government, private and philanthropic funding.

### *2. Strategic Framework*

The NRM Plan provides the Northern Gulf community (including NGRMG as the lead agency) with priority areas and strategies, particularly for improving land condition, maintaining biodiversity and improving the resilience of natural resource assets to climate change.

### *3. Internal Governance*

The NRM Plan provides a decision support tool and charter so that NGRMG management, operations and expenditure are focused and accountable.

### *4. Public Profile*

The NRM Plan clearly communicates to the Northern Gulf community and general public what the role of NGRMG is, and provides a foundation for public awareness raising and community education on strategic NRM priorities.
